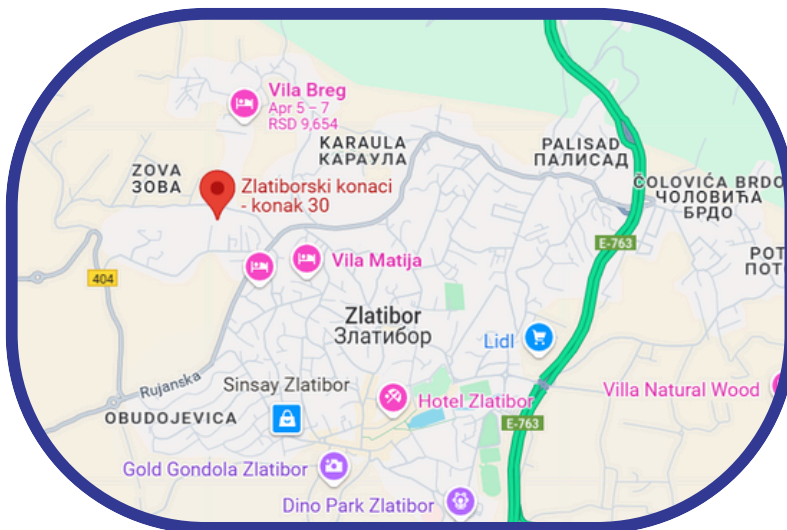

TRANSPORTATION

- There will be schedule bus service from a central hub in Zlatibor according to the sport program and other non sport activities. All sport venues in Zlatibor are reachable by foot. A designated board will be placed at the hotel where all
- information will be published daily. Bus services will be used for various purposes, including transportation to training and competition venues, arrivals and
- departures. All ceremonies and non-sport activities are reachable by foot from every hotel. There will be a WhatsApp group for daily communication and
- information.

FINANCES

► Balance fee payment

Balance fee payment = Participation fee - Deposit (*already paid*)

The balance fee payment is to be paid before the start of the event to the LOC account. All bank charges are to be met by the participating delegation.

Participation fee

The participation fee covers full board accommodation for the duration of the event plus competition, cultural program activities, and all local transport from the arrival to the official port of entry to the departure of the delegation.

The participation fee is composed of:

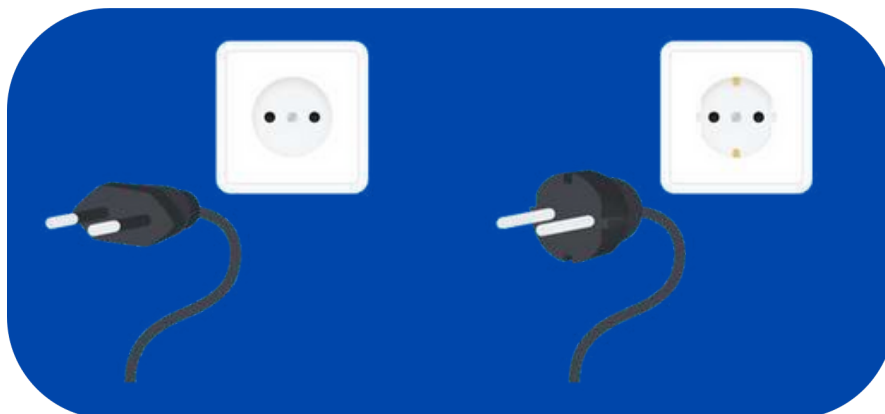

In Zlatibor, you can exchange currency at several licensed exchange offices located in key areas such as Miladina Pećinara Street, Kraljev trg, and near the bus station. Many tourist agencies and travel offices also provide exchange services. Most exchange offices operate daily and offer competitive rates. Additionally, banks and ATMs are widely available for currency exchange and cash withdrawals. It is advisable to check the exchange rate and any potential fees before making a transaction.

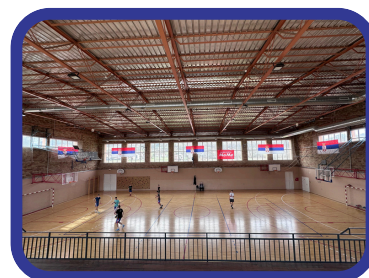

TRANSPORTATION TO COMPETITION VENUES

All teams will be provided with transportation from their hotels to the sports venues. In general, the bus will pick up participants directly from their hotel. However, in some cases, teams may need to walk a short distance to a nearby pickup point. If this applies to your hotel, you will be informed upon arrival.

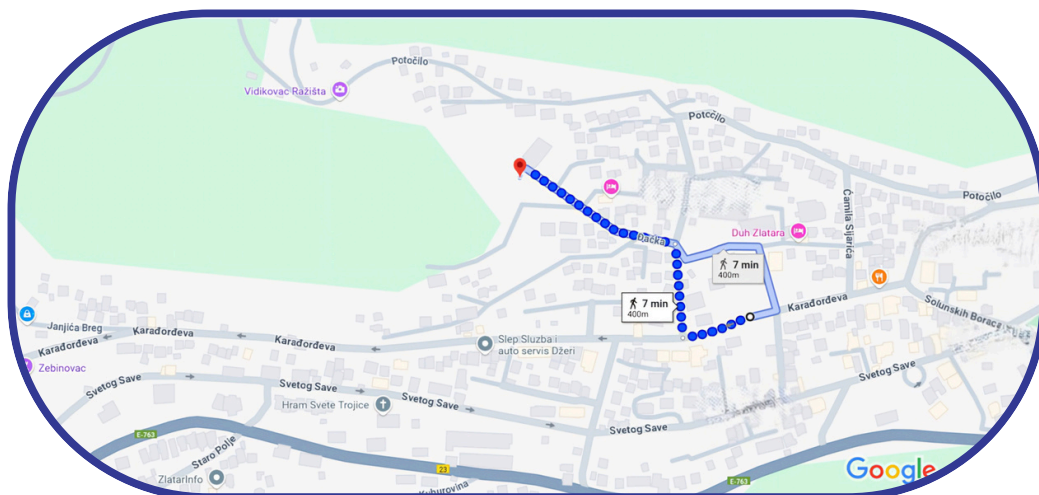
The buses will drop off participants directly at the entrance of the sports halls in **Arilje, Guča,** and **Čajetina**. For the **Nova Varoš** sports hall, due to limited access for buses, the drop-off point will be approximately 300 meters away from the venue. Teams will be guided by event staff to ensure a smooth and safe walk to the hall.

Below, you will find a map showing the exact path from the drop-off point to the Nova Varoš sports hall. Please refer to it for better orientation.

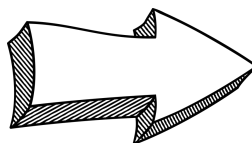

TECHNICAL RULES – ESC BASKETBALL U18

GAME RULES

- Each game consists of four quarters of 8 minutes.
- Warm-up time: 15 minutes before the start of the match.
- Game timing: The clock will run continuously except for the last 3 minutes of the 4th quarter, where the clock will stop for every game stoppage.
- Overtime (if required) will last 3 minutes, with the clock stopping in the last minute.
- Timeouts: Each team is allowed one timeout per quarter.
- Substitutions: Unlimited substitutions allowed but must be made during dead-ball situations.
- Shot clock: Standard 24-second shot clock will be used.
- Team fouls: A team will be in the bonus situation after committing five team fouls per quarter.
- Individual fouls: A player fouls out after committing five personal fouls.
- Jump ball: The game starts with a jump ball. The alternating possession rule applies afterward.
- Overtime: In case of a tie after four quarters, a 3-minute overtime will be played.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

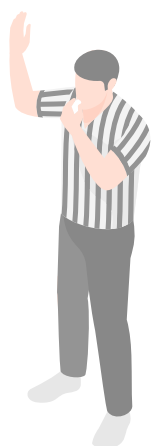
- Uniforms: Each team must wear matching uniforms with clearly visible numbers on both the front and back.
- Bench & Coaching Staff: Each team is allowed up to 12 players, with a maximum of 3 coaching staff members on the bench.
- Protests & Disputes: Any protest must be submitted in writing within 30 minutes after the match to the competition committee.
- Disciplinary Actions:
- Two technical fouls result in ejection from the game.
- Players or coaches who receive a disqualifying foul will be automatically suspended for the next game.

THREE-POINT SHOOTOUT COMPETITION (ONLY WOMEN'S CATEGORY)

- Each country may register up to four participants.
- Standard three-point contest format: three shooting stations, each with five balls (four regular balls worth 1 point, one money ball worth 2 points per station).
- Participants have one minute to complete their shots.
- Top scorers from the first round advance to the final.

3X3 BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT (ONLY WOMEN'S CATEGORY)

- Standard FIBA 3x3 rules apply.
- Games are played to 21 points or a maximum of 10 minutes, whichever comes first.
- A team must have at least 3 players to compete in a match.
- Possession alternates after each score, and there is a 12-second shot clock.
- These rules aim to ensure fair play, safety, and an exciting competition for all teams participating in ESC Basketball U18.



TECHNICAL RULES – ESC VOLLEYBALL U18

GAME RULES

- Each match is played in a best-of-three sets format.
- Set scoring: The first two sets are played to 25 points, with a minimum two-point advantage required to win. If the score is tied at 24-24, play continues until a team achieves a two-point lead.
- Decisive set: If the match reaches a third set, it is played to 15 points, with the same two-point advantage rule.
- Warm-up time: 15 minutes before the start of the match.
- Substitutions: Each team is allowed six substitutions per set. Players may re-enter only once per set.
- Timeouts: Each team is allowed two timeouts per set.
- Rotation & Service: Teams must follow a rotational order, and a fault will be called if a player serves out of turn.
- Net violations: Contact with the net during play is a fault, except if incidental and does not affect the play.
- Libero player: Each team may designate a libero, who can only play in the back row and cannot serve, attack, or block.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

- Uniforms: Each team must wear matching uniforms with clearly visible numbers on both the front and back. The libero must wear a contrasting jersey color.
- Bench & Coaching Staff: Each team is allowed up to 12 players, with a maximum of 3 coaching staff members on the bench.
- Protests & Disputes: Any protest must be submitted in writing within 30 minutes after the match to the competition committee.
- Disciplinary Actions: Two yellow cards in a match result in a red card, meaning loss of a point for the team.
- A red card without a prior yellow results in a player being sent off for the set but not the match.
- Any serious unsportsmanlike behavior (such as offensive language or aggression) results in an immediate ejection and possible suspension from the next match.
